

WAIVING POINTS OF ORDER AGAINST THE CONFERENCE
REPORT TO ACCOMPANY H.R. 3194, DISTRICT OF COLUM-
BIA APPROPRIATIONS ACT, 2000

REPORT

[To accompany H. Res. 386]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 386, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution waives all points of order against the conference report to accompany H.R. 3194, the District of Columbia Appropriations Act, 2000, and against its consideration. The rule further provides that the conference report shall be considered as read.

Section 2 of the resolution provides that, upon adoption of the conference report, the House shall be considered to have adopted a concurrent resolution providing that the conference report accompanying H.R. 2466 be laid on the table.

The waiver of all points of order includes a waiver of clause 8 of rule XXII (requiring a three-day layover of a conference report) because the conference report was not filed until Wednesday, November 17, and may be considered as early as Thursday, November 18. Also, the waiver of all points of order includes a waiver of clause 9 of rule XXII (prohibiting matters not specifically committed to the conference from being included in the conference report).
