**A BILL**

To provide for the participation of employees in the judicial branch in the Federal leave transfer program for disasters and emergencies.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. LEAVE TRANSFER PROGRAM IN DISASTERS**  
4       **AND EMERGENCIES.**

5       Section 6391 of title 5, United States Code, is  
6       amended—

1           (1) by redesignating subsection (f) as sub-  
2       section (g); and

3           (2) by inserting after subsection (e) the fol-  
4       lowing:

5       “(f) After consultation with the Administrative Office  
6       of the United States Courts, the Office of Personnel Man-  
7       agement shall provide for the participation of employees  
8       in the judicial branch in any emergency leave transfer pro-  
9       gram under this section.”.
