A BILL

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Wyoming.

- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR THE FEDERAL ENERGY REGULATORY COMMISSION HYDROELECTRIC PROJECT.
- 6 Notwithstanding the time period specified in section
- 7 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would
- 8 otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-
- 9 mission project numbered 1651, the Commission may, at
- 10 the request of the licensee for the project, and after rea-

- 1 sonable notice, in accordance with the good faith, due dili-
- 2 gence, and public interest requirements of that section and
- 3 the Commission's procedures under that section, extend
- 4 the time period during which the licensee is required to
- 5 commence the construction of the project for 3 consecutive
- 6 2-year periods from the date of the expiration of the exten-
- 7 sion originally issued by the Commission.
