AN ACT

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction
of a hydroelectric project in the State of Wyoming.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR THE FEDERAL EN-**
2 **ERGY REGULATORY COMMISSION HYDRO-**
3 **ELECTRIC PROJECT.**

4 Notwithstanding the time period specified in section
5 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would
6 otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-
7 mission project numbered 1651, the Commission may, at
8 the request of the licensee for the project, and after rea-
9 sonable notice, in accordance with the good faith, due dili-
10 gence, and public interest requirements of that section and
11 the Commission's procedures under that section, extend
12 the time period during which the licensee is required to
13 commence the construction of the project for 3 consecutive
14 2-year periods from the date of the expiration of the exten-
15 sion originally issued by the Commission.
