

***In the Senate of the United States,***

*December 18, 2018.*

*Resolved,* That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 6615) entitled “An Act to reauthorize the Traumatic Brain Injury program.”, do pass with the following

**AMENDMENT:**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 *This Act may be cited as the “Traumatic Brain Injury*  
3 *Program Reauthorization Act of 2018”.*

4 **SEC. 2. PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF INJURIES.**

5 *Part J of title III of the Public Health Service Act*  
6 *(42 U.S.C. 280b et seq.) is amended—*

7 *(1) in section 393C (42 U.S.C. 280b–1d) by add-*  
8 *ing at the end the following:*

9 *“(c) NATIONAL CONCUSSION DATA COLLECTION AND*  
10 *ANALYSIS.—The Secretary, acting through the Director of*  
11 *the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, may imple-*

1 *ment concussion data collection and analysis to determine*  
2 *the prevalence and incidence of concussion.”;*

3 *(2) in section 394A(b)(42 U.S.C. 280b–3(b)), by*  
4 *striking “\$6,564,000 for each of fiscal years 2015*  
5 *through 2019” and inserting “\$11,750,000 for each of*  
6 *fiscal years 2020 through 2024”;* and

7 *(3) by striking section 393C–1 (42 U.S.C. 280b–*  
8 *1e).*

9 **SEC. 3. STATE GRANTS FOR PROJECTS REGARDING TRAU-**  
10 **MATIC BRAIN INJURY.**

11 *Section 1252 of the Public Health Service Act (42*  
12 *U.S.C. 300d–52) is amended—*

13 *(1) in subsection (a), by inserting “, acting*  
14 *through the Administrator for the Administration for*  
15 *Community Living,” after “The Secretary”;*

16 *(2) by striking subsection (e);*

17 *(3) by redesignating subsections (f) through (j)*  
18 *as subsections (e) through (i), respectively; and*

19 *(4) in subsection (i), as so redesignated, by strik-*  
20 *ing “\$5,500,000 for each of the fiscal years 2015*  
21 *through 2019” and inserting “\$7,321,000 for each of*  
22 *fiscal years 2020 through 2024”.*

1 **SEC. 4. STATE GRANTS FOR PROTECTION AND ADVOCACY**  
2 **SERVICES.**

3 *Section 1253 of the Public Health Service Act (42*  
4 *U.S.C. 300d–53) is amended—*

5 *(1) in subsection (a), by inserting “, acting*  
6 *through the Administrator for the Administration for*  
7 *Community Living,” after “The Secretary”; and*

8 *(2) in subsection (l), by striking “\$3,100,000 for*  
9 *each of the fiscal years 2015 through 2019” and in-*  
10 *serting “\$4,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2020*  
11 *through 2024”.*
