Reports Filed: Reports were filed today as follows:

H.R. 5636, to designate additions to the Flatside Wilderness on the Ouachita National Forest, and for other purposes, with an amendment (H. Rept. 115–989);

H.R. 5171, to amend the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Management Act of 1996 to provide for the establishment of a Ski Area Fee Retention Account (H. Rept. 115–990, Part 1);

H.R. 5706, to establish the Pearl Harbor National Memorial in the State of Hawai'i and the Honouliuli National Historic Site in the State of Hawai'i, and for other purposes (H. Rept. 115–991);

H.R. 4644, to withdraw certain National Forest System land in the Emigrant Crevice area located in the Custer Gallatin National Forest, Park County, Montana, from the mining and mineral leasing laws of the United States, and for other purposes (H. Rept. 115–992);

H.R. 210, to facilitate the development of energy on Indian lands by reducing Federal regulations that impede tribal development of Indian lands, and for other purposes, with an amendment (H. Rept. 115–993);

H.R. 6302, to enact as law certain regulations relating to the taking of double-crested cormorants, with an amendment (H. Rept. 115–994); and

H.R. 6666, to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to grant to States and local governments easements and rights-of-way over Federal land within Gateway National Recreation Area for construction, operation, and maintenance of projects for control and prevention of flooding and shoreline erosion (H. Rept. 115–995). **Page H9442**
