3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Rebuilding Small Busi-
5 nesses After Disasters Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF SUNSET FOR COLLATERAL REQUIRE-**
7 **MENTS FOR SBA DISASTER LOANS.**
