PETITIONS, ETC.

Under clause 3 of rule XII, petitions and papers were laid on the clerk's desk and referred as follows:

50. The SPEAKER presented a petition of the Legislature of Rockland County, NY, relative to Resolution No. 405 of 2019, urging Congress to fully fund the 2020 Census to ensure a complete and accurate count for all people; to the Committee on Oversight and Reform.

51. Also, a petition of New Jersey State Federation of Women's Clubs of GFWC, relative to a resolution strongly urging the US Congress to reintroduce and pass the SCREEN Act to provide the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) with stronger recall and seizure authority to disrupt the entry of counterfeit and illicit drugs through International Mail Facilities; jointly to the Committees on Energy and Commerce and the Budget.

52. Also, a petition of New Jersey State Federation of Women's Club of GFWC, relative to a resolution strongly urging Congress to enact legislation which would strike the non-interference clause and direct the Secretary of Health and Human Services to negotiate lower prices with drug manufacturers that participate in Medicare Part D on behalf of Medicare beneficiaries; jointly to the Committees on Energy and Commerce and Ways and Means.

53. Also, a petition of Government of Puerto Rico House of Representatives, relative to Concurrent Resolution 109, to express the greatest posthumous recognition of the Legislative Assembly of Puerto Rico and pay homage to Lieutenant Augusto Rodriguez as a hero of the American Civil War in honor of his achievements as the first known Puerto Rican veteran of the United States Armed Forces; jointly to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs and Natural Resources.

54. Also, a petition of Interstate Oil and Gas Compact Commission, relative to Resolution 19.081, urging The President of the United States and the Congress to oppose the Green New Deal, or any substantively similar legislation, and support allowing states to continue to develop their own energy policies; jointly to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, Science, Space, and Technology, Education and Labor, Transportation and Infrastructure, Agriculture, Natural Resources, Foreign Affairs, Financial Services, the Judiciary, Ways and Means, and Oversight and Reform.
