## HIGHLIGHTS

The House passed H.J. Res. 129, Making Further Continuing Appropriations.

Agreed to the Senate amendments to H.R. 5630, Intelligence Authorization—clearing the measure for the President.

## Senate

#### Measures Passed:

**Relative to the Death of Representative Dixon:** Senate agreed to S. Res. 387, relative to the death of Representative Julian C. Dixon of California. **Pages S11755–56, S11763**

**Omnibus Indian Advancement Act:** Senate passed H.R. 5528, to authorize the construction of a Wakpa Sica Reconciliation Place in Fort Pierre, South Dakota, clearing the measure for the President. **Pages S11757–60**

**Enrollment Correction:** Senate agreed to S. Con. Res. 161, to correct the enrollment of H.R. 5528. **Pages S11759–60, S11762**

**Indian Tribal Justice Technical and Legal Assistance Act:** Senate concurred in the amendment of the House to S. 1508, to provide technical and legal as-

sistance for tribal justice systems and members of Indian tribes, clearing the measure for the President.

**Continuing Resolution—Agreement:** A unanimous-consent agreement was reached providing that when the Senate receives from the House the joint resolution funding the Government until Friday, December 15, it be considered read a third time and passed. **Page S11756**
