The rule waives all points of order against consideration of the joint resolution. Finally, the rule provides one motion to recommit.

### **MAKING FURTHER CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2001**

*Committee on Rules:* Granted, by voice vote, a closed rule on H.J. Res. 134, making further continuing appropriations for the fiscal year 2001, providing one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropriations. The rule waives all points of order against consideration of the joint resolution. Finally, the rule provides one motion to recommit.

### **RULES WAIVING A REQUIREMENT WITH RESPECT TO CONSIDERATION OF CERTAIN RESOLUTIONS**

*Committee on Rules:* Granted, by voice vote, a rule waiving clause 6(a) of rule XIII (requiring a two-thirds vote to consider a rule on the same day it is reported from the Rules Committee) against certain resolutions reported from the Rules Committee. The rule applies the waiver to a special rule reported on the legislative day of December 15, 2000, providing for consideration or disposition of a conference report to accompany H.R. 4577, making appropriations for the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2001, and for other purposes, or any amendment reported in disagreement from a conference thereon.
